With over 20,000 books currently available, the entire U.S. Federal Census, PERSI™, Freedman's Bank Records, Revolutionary War Pension Records, and other expanding collections, HeritageQuest Online gives our library patrons the opportunity to tap into one of the largest collections of genealogy material in the country.



EBSCOhost is a family of research databases which include the following:

🔑 **Auto Repair Reference Center**

Provides information on:

- Approximately 26,000 vehicles both domestic and foreign including vintage make from 1945 to present
- Approximately 70,000 technical service bulletins & recalls issued by the original equipment vehicle manufacturer
- Wiring Diagrams, factory drawings, step-by-step photographs
- Specifications & Maintenance schedules
- Auto IQ: complete guide to vehicle ownership & maintenance

🔑 **Book Collection: Nonfiction**

A research database for both school and public libraries. It contains informative abstracts and searchable full text for more than 3,600 popular nonfiction books. The database includes full text entries on core subject areas, as well as information on careers, health, sports, adventure, technology, life skills and more.

🔑 **Business Source Premier**

The industry's most used business research database, providing full text for more than 2,300 journals, including full text for more than 1,100 peer-reviewed titles. Business Source Premier is superior to the competition in full text coverage in all disciplines of business, including marketing, management, MIS, POM, accounting, finance and economics. This database is updated daily on EBSCOhost.

🔑 **ERIC**

The Educational Resource Information Center (ERIC), contains more than 2,200 digests along with references for additional information and citations and abstracts from over 1,000 educational and education-related journals.

🔑 **Funk & Wagnalls New World Encyclopedia**

Provides over 25,000 encyclopedic entries covering a variety of subject areas.

🔑 **Health Source - Consumer Edition**

This database is the richest collection of consumer health information available to libraries worldwide, providing information on many health topics including the medical sciences, food sciences and nutrition, childcare, sports medicine and general health. Health Source: Consumer Edition features more than 130 full text, consumer health magazines. This database is updated on a daily basis.

🔑 **History Reference Center**

Offers full text from more than 2,000 reference books, encyclopedias and non-fiction books, cover to cover full text for more than 120 history periodicals, 59,000 historical documents, 49,600 biographies of historical figures, more than 104,720 historical photos and maps, and more than 80 hours of historical video.

🔑 **MagillOnLiterature Plus**

MagillOnLiterature Plus, produced by Salem Press, is the premier literary database, combining MagillOnLiterature and MagillOnAuthors. This database includes all the literary works, reviewed critical analyses and brief plot summaries that are included in MagillOnLiterature, as well as all the biographies and author essays included in MagillOnAuthors.

🔑 **Newspaper Source**

Offers selected full text for 25 national (U.S.) and international newspapers. The database also contains full text television & radio news transcripts, and selected full text for more than 260 regional (U.S.) newspapers. This database is updated daily via EBSCOhost.

🔑 **NoveList**

A fiction database that provides subject heading access, reviews, annotations, and much more for over 135,000 fiction titles. It also includes other content of interest to fiction readers, such as Author Read-alikes, What We're Reading, Book Discussion Guides, BookTalks, and Annotated Book Lists. For school media specialists and teachers there are Picture Book Extenders and articles on Teaching with Fiction.

🔑 **Primary Search**

Contains full text for nearly 70 popular, magazines for elementary school research. All full text articles included in the database are assigned a reading level indicator (Lexiles), and full text information dates as far back as 1990. This database is updated daily on EBSCOhost.

🔑 **Professional Development Collection**

Designed for professional educators, this database provides a highly specialized collection of 520 high quality education journals, including nearly 350 peer-reviewed titles. This database also contains more than 200 educational reports.

Professional Development Collection is the most compre-

hensive collection of full text education journals in the world.

🔑 **Regional Business News**

This database provides comprehensive full text coverage for regional business publications. Regional Business News incorporates coverage of 75 business journals, newspapers and newswires from all metropolitan and rural areas within the United States. This database is updated on a daily basis.

🔑 **The Serials Directory**

Provides access to the most up-to-date and accurate bibliographic information as well as current pricing structures for popular serials. This invaluable resource is made available via EBSCOhost®. It contains nearly 212,000 U.S. and international titles, including newspapers; data from nearly 108,235 publishers worldwide, including e-mail and Internet addresses; and Library of Congress and Dewey Decimal Classifications for every entry.
